

PCC BOARD OF GOVERNORS LONG RANGE PLANNING GOALS – 2011
Updated with Status of Initiatives – October, 2011

- Online Access to Credit Book Balance/Details and Member Statements
 - Planned for 2012
- Online Tee Time Booking System
 - Jim Dries, VP of Club Essential, is expected to make a proposal to the BOG's to develop a definition of what an on line tee time system should be and how it would interface with the existing PCC software.
 - Rich Wainwright will define the requirements
- Pro Shop Discounts For All Members
 - Member Only Merchandise with Member Logo
 - Member logo is being redesigned; once completed, men's and women's shirts will be available
- Allow Members to Use Push Carts – No activity
- Member's Clubhouse Renovation
 - Create Member Advisory Committee to Provide Input
 - Board Blog post and poll was used to gather input from members
 - House Committee has provided input
 - Walkthrough has been done to define potential changes/updates
 - Changes / updates will be reviewed with the Board of Governors
 - Private Cart Parking Convenient to Members' Club
 - Space in "caddy" lot being considered
 - Exercise Facility / Equipment
 - No activity until after 2014 US Opens; space will be used by the US Open staff
- Member's Clubhouse Dining Enhancement
 - No Reservation Dining
 - Some dining changes have been made to include more ala carte events
 - Couples' / Mixed Evening Activities (e.g., 9 and Dine Events)
 - Three events have been held at No. 6
- Quarterly or Semi-Annual Payments of Private Cart Fees
 - PCC management is working on this; expected for 2012
- Sod and Laser Level Croquet and Lawn Bowling Courts
 - Probably 2012
- Additional Set of Forward Tees for Courses No. 1, 3 & 5

- New forward tees on Course No. 3 holes #14 and #16 and Course No. 1 hole #11 planned to be complete before year end
 - Blended set of tees being considered
- Promote awareness and increased usage of family tees
- Resolve Issues with Railroad Crossing from #18 holes of Courses No. 3 & 5
 - Complete
- At least twice a year one day golf outings
