



110th Men's North & South Amateur Championship

Invitation and Application Process

Invitations

- Players meeting our exemption criteria will be invited to compete.
- Players meeting exemption criteria will be accepted upon receipt of invitation or application.
 - Players meeting these criteria will be guaranteed acceptance unless more than 125 exempt players accept invitations to compete. If this occurs, players will be granted entry into the Championship based on their highest level of exemption status. (C1 precedes C2 so on and so forth).

Applications

- Players not meeting exemption criteria may formally apply via application.
- Players not meeting exemption criteria may ask for an “At Large” invitation by sending your playing resume to Tournaments@pinehurst.com.
 - These will be assessed by our tournament committee and chosen prior to the entry deadline; these are on a case by case basis and will typically number 1-4 players.
 - All decisions are at the discretion of the tournament committee and all decisions are final.

Close of Entries

- Invitations and applications are received, processed, and ranked. Top 110-120 player field is determined (field size depends on strength of resumes and rankings of applicants).
- All players not accepted into the Championship are issued regrets and invited to compete in the Open Qualifier.

Open Qualifying

- All players not accepted into the Championship via formal application process are invited to compete. (No other entries will be accepted for the Open Qualifier.)
- Depending on strength of applicants, the number of positions available will be determined. (minimum of 5).
- Players finishing in the qualifying spots are entered into the Men's Championship and will compete in 18 holes of medal play on Tuesday June 29, 2010 to determine match play seeds.
