Samuel Ryder: Ryder was an English nurseryman who made his fortune marketing penny seed packets. He took up golf after his 50th birthday, initiated the Ryder Cup competition and became a lifelong patron of the game.

**Chinese Chicken Salad. \$8.95**

Shredded chicken breast, iceberg lettuce, napa cabbage, bean sprouts, macademia nuts and mandarin oranges topped with sliced green onion and crisp won tons in sweet sesame Vinaigrette.

**Southern Cobb Salad. \$9.95**

Iceberg lettuce leaves with diced smoked ham, fresh roast turkey breast, diced tomatoes, avocado, crumbled blue cheese, toasted garlic croutons and thousand island dressing.

**Albacore Tuna or Chicken Salad Croissant. \$7.75**

With cheddar cheese, alfalfa sprouts and tomato.

**Pinehurst Club Sandwich. \$7.95**

Triple decker of shaved fresh roast turkey breast and smoked ham with crisp bacon, mayonnaise, lettuce and tomato on your choice of bread.

**The Burger. \$9.25**

A half pound of choice ground burger charbroiled and served on a roasted onion sourdough bread, green leaf lettuce, ripe tomatoes, sliced pickle, Bermuda onion, crisp French fries and battered onion rings. **Grilled Corn Beef Rubeen. \$8.95**

Shaved corned beef, swiss cheese, sauerkraut and thousand island dressing on marble rye bread. Served with French fries.

**Traditional Tuna Melt. \$9.25**

Our house made tuna open faced with tomato on grilled rye pumpernickle with melted swiss cheese.

**BBQ Mahi-Mahi Wrap. \$8.95**

With avocado, slaw & corn relish in a flour tortilla accompanied by onion rings.

**French Dip. \$9.50**

Prime rib of beef thinly sliced topped with provolone cheese served with au jus on a butter grilled hoagie roll.

**Shredded Chicken & Spicy Tasso Wrap. \$8.95**

Shredded chicken & tasso ham, baby spinach, bermuda onion, diced tomato finished with pepper jack cheese in a grilled flour tortilla, cilantro sour cream fresh pico de gallo, fresh fried tortilla chips.
