



63RD DONALD ROSS JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP



Championship Information

Format: The Donald Ross Junior Championship consists of 36-holes of stroke play in three age groups. Boys ages 15 - 17 compete on Pinehurst No. 4 and No. 5, while boys ages 12 – 14, and 11 & Under compete on Pinehurst No. 1. *(All age groups will compete against their own division and independently of the other divisions.)* Both rounds begin with shotgun starts each day.

Following the Championship is an optional Father/Son Event. Juniors must play in the Championship to be eligible for the Father/Son Event. The format of the Father/Son Event is alternate shot with selected drive. Age groups remain the same as the Junior Championship, with play contested on Pinehurst No. 8. If there are more than three (3) golf professional/son teams in each division, professional divisions will be formed. Play is aided by the use of golf carts. Father/Son teams are limited to fathers and sons.

Championship Registration: Championship Registration will be held on Monday, December 27, from 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM in the St. Andrews Room of the Pinehurst Resort Club. All contestants must register in person during this time. Neither parents nor guardians may register for a contestant. If word is not received in the Pinehurst Tournament Office as to the status of a player's registration by 5:00 PM on December 27, 2010 the penalty is disqualification.

Practice Rounds: Complimentary practice rounds on Pinehurst No. 1, No.4, and No. 5 will be available on Monday, December 27, 2010. **Practice rounds are for contestants only.** Practice round times may be made on Wednesday, December 22, 2010 from 10:00-11:00 AM, or between 9:00-11:00 AM after December 22, by calling the Pinehurst Starting Tower at 910.295.3186 or 800.795.4653 (select option 6). Please indicate that you are a contestant in the Donald Ross Junior Championship.

Additional Golf: For those staying on property, all additional golf can be arrange when booking your reservation or by calling the Starting Tower (number above) after 10:00 AM Wednesday, December 22, 2010, or contacting the Pinehurst Golf Shop (910.235.8152) between the hours of 11:00 AM-4:00 PM. Participants accompanied by a paying adult enjoy complementary greens fees. Participants playing additional golf without being accompanied by a playing adult will be charged \$35 per player per round on Courses No.1, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8.

For those participants not staying on property you may contact the Pinehurst Golf Shop at 910.235.8152 the day prior to play, after 11:00 AM, to reserve a starting time. Times will be available December 23-31. Participants not staying on property will be charged \$65 per player per round on Courses No.1, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8.

Adults not staying at the Resort will be charged walk-on rates

Please note that Course No.2 & Course No.3 will be closed this winter due renovations.

Range Usage: Practice balls will be complimentary prior to and following Practice Rounds and Championship Rounds.

Carts/Caddies: Carts and caddies are prohibited during play. ALL contestants are required to walk and carry their own bag. Pull carts are also prohibited.

For the Father/Son Event, carts are provided, and the driver must have a valid driver's license.

Spectator carts will be permitted during play and are offered for a daily fee of \$34 (inclusive), based on availability.

Club Storage: Club Storage is available and complimentary for all contestants during the Championship. Players are asked to attach their Championship bag tag for identification purposes.

Dress Code

Pinehurst Resort and The Donald Ross Junior Championship Committee require collared shirts be worn at all times during the Championship, including practice rounds, Championship rounds, and the Father/Son competition.
