ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to male golfers who are age 18 or under, and have **NOT** completed high school. Play will be contested in three age divisions: 11 and Under Division, 12-14 Division, and 15-18 Division. A separate Father/Son competition will be contested for players and their fathers/guardians on December 30, 2011. Players must have participated in the 64th Donald Ross Junior Championship in order to be eligible to play in the Father/Son competition.

ACCEPTANCE

All completely executed applications must be **RECEIVED** no later than 5:00 PM Eastern Daylight Time **TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 29, 2011**. No entries will be accepted incomplete or after the deadline. The final field will be determined and confirmations or regrets sent to applicants via U.S. Mail. Submission/receipt of application does not in itself guarantee acceptance. Division will have a maximum number of players allowed as follows:

- 11 and Under Division – no limit
- 12 to 14 Division - 72 players
- 15 to 18 Division - 176 players

Players will be accepted on a first received/first accepted basis.

During the application process, applications received will be posted on the Championship website. Names posted at this location designate only applications received and does not guarantee acceptance. Please make checks out to Pinehurst, LLC or provide complete credit card information on the application form. Checks will not be cashed and credit cards will not be charged until a week before the championship begins.

Any player withdrawing prior to the close of entries will receive a full refund. Cancellations made after the closing date, but before December 22, 2011, will receive a refund less a \$30 processing fee. Cancellations after December 22, 2011 will not be provided a refund. Those applicants not accepted will be put on the alternate list and will not be charged, but payment information will be kept on file in case of acceptance.

Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the Championship. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct by contestants and/or parent/guardian.

CONDITIONS

Field: The field size for the 64th Donald Ross Junior Championship will vary. Contestants in the 11 and Under Division will be unlimited. The 12 to 14 Division will be limited to the first 72 applicants. Both of these divisions will play two days on Pinehurst No. 1. The 15-18 division will compete in 36-holes of stroke play, one round each on Pinehurst No. 4 and No. 5 and will be limited to the first 176 applicants.

Rules for Play: The Championship Rounds shall be played in accordance with the USGA Rules of Golf 2010-2011 and the Local Rules as defined by the 64th Donald Ross Junior Championship Committee. Unbecoming conduct by a player may result in disqualification.

Carts/Caddies: Carts and caddies are prohibited during play. ALL contestants are required to walk and carry their own bag. Pull carts are also prohibited. For the Father/Son Event, carts are provided, and the driver must have a valid driver's license.

Spectator carts will be permitted during play and are offered for a daily fee of \$34 (inclusive), based on availability

Dress Code: Pinehurst Resort and The Donald Ross Junior Championship Committee require collared shirts be worn at all times during the Championship, including practice rounds, Championship rounds, and the Father/Son competition.

FATHER/SON TOURNAMENT

The Father/Son tournament will be played Friday, December 30, on Pinehurst No. 4. The USGA Rules of Golf will govern play. The format is alternate shot with selected drive. Age groups will be the same as the Donald Ross Junior Championship. Players must play in the Championship to be eligible to participate in the Father/Son Tournament. Fees for the junior player are included in the Donald Ross Junior Championship entry fee; father entry fee is \$130.00. A minimum of three pro/son teams in any age group will constitute a separate pro division. Carts are mandatory for the Father/Son Tournament. Cart and range fees are included in the Father/Son entry fee.

REGISTRATION / CHECK-IN

Championship Registration will be held on Tuesday, December 27, from 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM in the St. Andrews Room of the Pinehurst Resort Club. All contestants must register in person during this time. Failure to register or notify the tournament office by 5:00 PM on December 27, may result in disqualification.

PRACTICE ROUNDS / ADDITIONAL GOLF

The official practice rounds will be held on Tuesday December 27, 2011. The complimentary practice round is for **contestants only** and may be reserved on their respective championship course (No. 1, No. 5, No. 4).

For Those Staying at Pinehurst Resort – Official Practice round tee times as well as any additional tee times may be booked via our Social Sales Department once reservations are confirmed. Participants accompanied by a paying adult enjoy complimentary greens fees. Participants playing additional golf without being accompanied by a playing adult will be charged \$35 per player per round on Courses No.1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8. (*See below for special No. 2 rates*)

For Those NOT Staying at the Resort - Practice round times may be made starting on Thursday, December 22, 2011, between the hours of 10:00 AM – 11:00 AM by calling the Pinehurst Starting Tower at 910.295.3186 or 800.795.4653 (select option 6). Please indicate that you are a contestant in the Donald Ross Junior Championship. For those participants not staying on property you may contact the Pinehurst Golf Shop at 910.235.8152 the day prior to play, after 11:00 AM, to reserve a starting time. Participants not staying on property will be charged \$65 per player per round on Courses No.1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8. ****Adults not staying at the Resort will be charged walk-on rates****

Range Usage: Practice balls will be complimentary prior to and following Practice Rounds and Championship Rounds.

Club Storage: Club Storage is available and complimentary for all contestants during the Championship. Players are asked to attach their Championship bag tag for identification purposes.
