Within the two-hour activity, teams will be tasked with creating solar cars from kits provided, and also building cars from materials used and thrown away everyday by millions of Americans. The solar cars will be put to the test and judged for performance, while the recycled cars will be built for speed! The event concludes with a round robin drag race tournament to determine which car is the fastest! Teams are racing against the clock to complete both cars and take home the checkered flag.

We partner with local schools to donate both the solar cars created during the event, as well as new solar car kits and a solar classroom curriculum to students. These cars and new car kits will be used by the schools to further emphasize the importance of energy conservation and alternative methods of transportation as well as foster creativity and innovation within the classroom.

Community HeART

Public institutions, such as inner-city schools, hospitals, and community centers, can be very intimidating atmospheres, oftentimes colorless, lifeless, and certainly not inviting. The goal of this activity is to create colorful, stimulating artwork to donate to local communities to help brighten the halls of these institutions. The end result is a lasting, memorable donation of murals to the destination community!

Teams must mix the different skills from their team palette to complete tasks required to obtain the materials needed for their artistic creations. Once teams have "Identified the Artists," "Spoken the Language," "Mixed the Colors," and "Made Shapes", only then will they receive their canvas and materials necessary to move forward. With our color-by-number system, no artistic skill is necessary!

We partner with local beneficiaries within the community to donate the murals. At the end of the activity, a representative from the beneficiary can be present to accept the donation and thank your group for your teamwork and hard work in completing this wonderful gift.

The Best Medicine

Hospitals can be very intimidating atmospheres...especially for children enduring short-term or extended hospital stays. These environs often do not exhibit comfortable attributes for sick and healing children to FEEL AND ACT LIKE CHILDREN! The goal of this activity is to prepare piñatas, stuffed with gifts, toys and games to donate to children who are enduring hospital stays. The end result is a meaningful and memorable donation of heartwarming gifts for children in a local hospital who can use some serious cheering up!

During this two-hour activity, teams start with an empty piñata shell and a "Team Activity Packet". Working together, teams must complete fun medical-oriented tasks such as "Operation", "Wound Dressing Relay", and the "Organ Transfer" to earn enough points to purchase the materials needed to design and decorate their piñata. Teams are racing against the clock to complete their tasks and to make the most creative piñata for children in need of a smile.

We partner with local children's hospitals to donate the piñatas, as well as coloring books that each team is a part of designing. At the end of the activity, a representative from the benefitting hospital can be present to accept the donation and thank the group for their teamwork in completing these wonderful gifts.

Eco-sino! A GREEN Casino

The environment and global warming have been much-publicized topics over the last several years. Given this increased focus, Impact 4 Good has created an activity that showcases the importance of going green, which benefits local communities, and builds on the popularity of traditional "Casino Night" events.

The goal within the three-hour activity is for teams to devise a strategy to maximize winnings at the exciting professionally managed casino tables and "Eco-Activity Stations" around the room.

Teams visit all the tables and eco-activity stations and play to earn as many chips as possible as a team (not as individuals)! As they complete a table or activity station, teams also receive "Fact Cards" that include sentence fragments. When assembled in the correct order, the sentence fragments form environmental facts. At the close of this innovative, Las Vegas-style casino, team earnings are tallied and environmental facts are read aloud. Teams with correctly constructed facts earn bonus \$\$\$ to add to their winnings!! The team with the most money at the end of the night wins!

Prizes can be awarded to the teams with the most chips, if desired, however, the true winners of the event are revealed at the end, when the group learns that a GET GREEN kit will be donated on behalf of each team to the local community, which consists of items that will help beneficiary families have greener homes and communities, and will help them protect the environment! These kits are also useful because they are products that will save families money by going green!

We partner with local Habitat for Humanity affiliates, community centers, schools and/or other community organizations to make the donation possible.

Bike Build for Charity

The joy of being a kid and being presented with your first bicycle is unmatched. Remember that feeling? Yet many children throughout the United States are unable to experience that joy. This competitive event is extremely high-energy and interactive, with participants competing in teams to score points and earn bicycle parts. The event involves large numbers of people competing in physical and mental challenges straight out of the gate, and calls for team participation and strong support throughout! At the end of the day, points are tallied, but the real winners are the children that receive the assembled bicycles and Big Wheels as a donation! Is your group ready for the great team challenge?!
